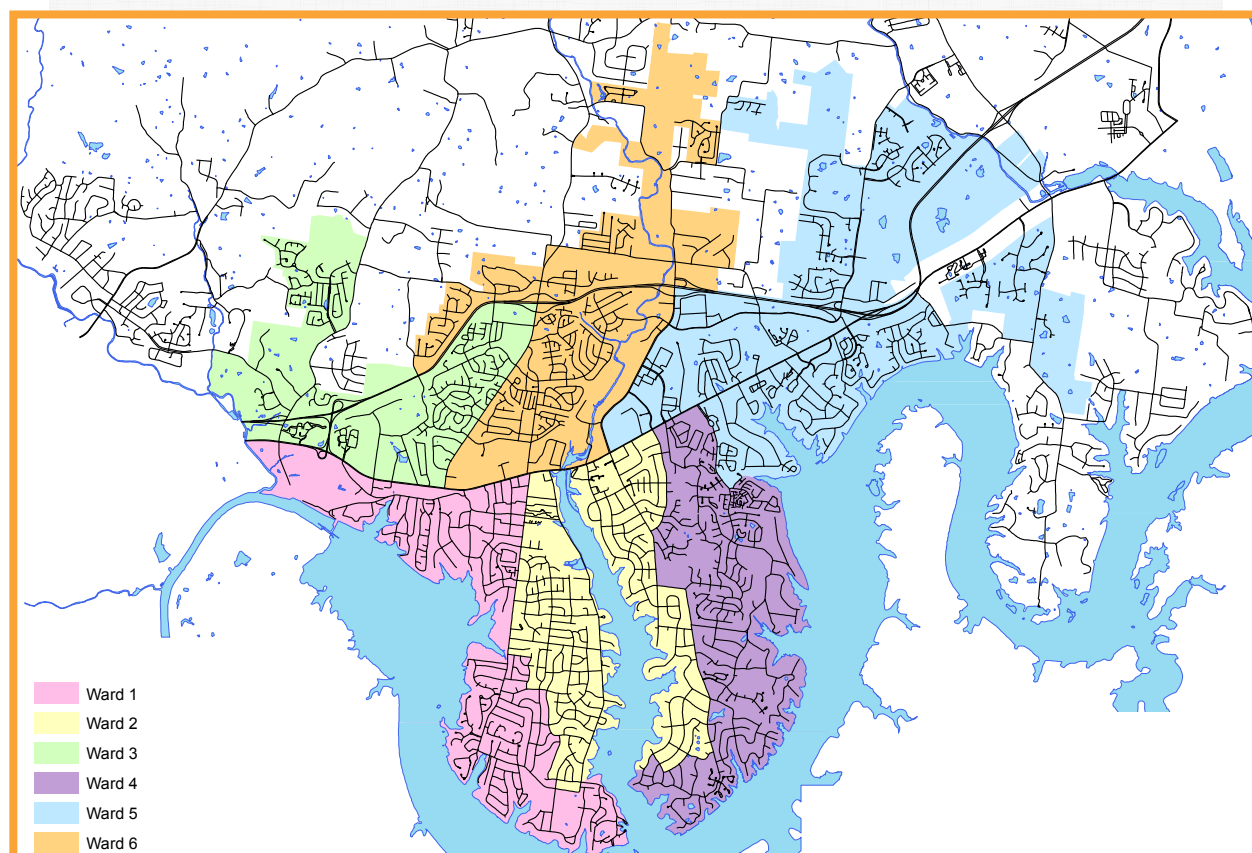

honoring OUR HISTORIC PAST

PRIDE IN TRADITION AND LANDMARKS

With Nashville to the south and Gallatin to the east, Hendersonville was a comfortable midpoint for a farming village along Highway 31E. Where the highway met Walton Ferry Road and Old Shackle Island Road, a handful of businesses sat within walking distance of a hundred homes.

Old Hickory Dam converted the quiet village into The City by the Lake. It created two peninsulas, widened Drakes Creek, and formed scenic coves that gained attention. Musicians and industry executives noticed the transformation early. At the same time, the nation's population was shifting to suburbs

and to the Sun Belt. To handle the growth, several long-time residents led an effort to form a city government. They succeeded in 1969, by forming the smallest city in Tennessee, just 262 residents and .18 square miles.

New residents usually found Hendersonville after landing professional jobs in Nashville. Between them and rapid annexations beyond the original city borders, Hendersonville was the fastest growing city in the nation during the 1970s. Johnny Cash, Conway Twitty, the Oak Ridge Boys, Roy Orbison, Mandrell sisters, and other country favorites were meeting neighbors who appreciated exemplary schools, active churches, and weekends of recreation.

With a concerted effort in the 1980s and 1990s, Hendersonville began keeping its talent at home during

weekdays. The city and chamber of commerce constantly encouraged residents to shop local. They also assisted existing companies that needed to expand while they recruited other businesses from far away. The city opened Freehill Business Park. Filling quickly with industrial and assembly plants, the park's success generated investments in nearby class A office space.

The professionals who lived here found more opportunities to work here.

Additional professional employers, completion of Vietnam Veterans Boulevard, and continued population growth brought a wave of retailers and restaurants. By setting their buildings along New Shackle Island Road and Indian Lake Boulevard, they extended the community beyond its iconic linear stretch of Highway 31E.

The city annexed new homes north of Vietnam Veterans Boulevard and east to Saundersville Road, areas that had once been considered far outside Hendersonville. The newest subdivisions added parks and pools while the city cleared land for dozens of playgrounds and team sports. The lake remained an attraction.

The visiting athletes and customers noticed Hendersonville's attributes. More moved here and opened businesses. One transplant, Taylor Swift, shot toward stardom. The Streets of Indian Lake opened, bringing

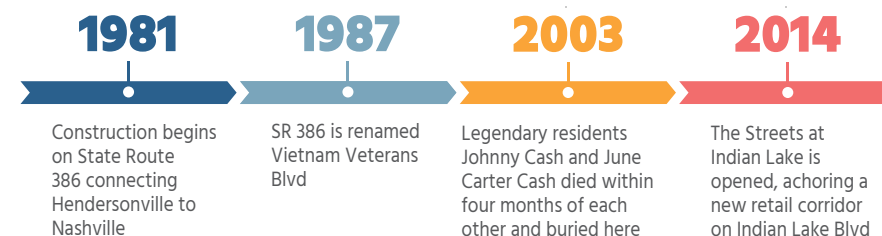
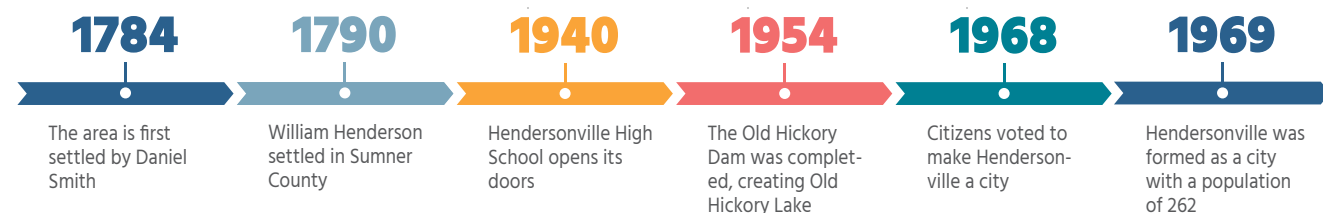
additional outsiders to Hendersonville for their first time.

The city's population climbed above 60,000 as it celebrated the 50th anniversary of becoming a city.

Completed in 1796, Rock Castle is the oldest home in Middle Tennessee. The former home of Revolutionary War hero and U.S. Senator, Daniel Smith, has been meticulously preserved and offers tours daily.



Monthaven is on the National Historic Register. Built around 1860, it was used as a field hospital during the Civil War. The building is now home to art galleries and offices of the Monthaven Arts & Cultural Center.



NATURAL beauty

PARKS, GREENWAYS AND RECREATION

Were it not for the creation of Old Hickory Lake, Hendersonville could well be known as “the City of Parks” instead of its current nickname, “the City by the Lake.” Hendersonville is home to a unique network of parks that encompass hundreds of acres of woods, fields and recreational facilities.

Hendersonville residents are fortunate to be able to take advantage of some of the most beautiful parks in the country. Local sports teams, runners,

swimmers and many others enjoy the parks and green spaces on a year-round basis.

However, locals are not the only ones who visit our parks and greenways. Each year, our parks system plays host to thousands of visitors who come to the area for a variety of sporting and musical events. From softball and soccer tournaments to the annual Freedom Festival and Sumner Fest events, the parks provide outstanding venues that draw tourists.

DRAKES CREEK PARK 120 East Main Street

Drakes Creek Park is one of the city’s busiest green spaces, attracting thousands of locals and tourists each year. Home to Hendersonville High School’s soccer and baseball fields, the park also boasts many additional amenities, including softball fields, playgrounds, basketball goals, sand volleyball courts, picnic shelters and a walking/running trail. Every July 3, Drakes Creek Park hosts the annual Freedom Festival that draws tens of thousands of visitors to Hendersonville.

MEMORIAL PARK 151 East Main Street

Located across the street from Drakes Creek Park, Memorial Park is host to a variety of recreational facilities, including a tennis complex, the Kids’ Kingdom play ground and a dog park. A popular fishing hotspot for Drakes Creek, Memorial Park is also home to two of the city’s scenic attractions, the Friendship Bridge and Friendship Island. Each December, the park hosts the city’s annual Christmas Tree lighting ceremony.

VETERANS PARK 144 Scotch Street

Veterans Park is one of Hendersonville’s most high-profile recreational facilities. Visible from Highway 386, the park represents one of the first views of the city for many visitors. Home to Beech High School’s softball field, Veterans Park also hosts the city’s two inline hockey rinks as well as a skate park. Its scenic walking and biking trails draw exercise enthusiasts on a regular basis. In late 2018, Veterans Park became the home of Mary’s Magical Place, the city’s all-inclusive playground for all children and their families.

SANDERS FERRY PARK 513 Sanders Ferry Road

Sanders Ferry Park is another popular destination for recreation enthusiasts in the City by the Lake. The park offers a wide variety of amenities, including an 18-hole disc golf course, a radio-controlled airplane field, picnic shelters, an entertainment pavilion and walking/ biking trails. Sanders Ferry Park also features certified cross-country running course that hosts several high school and middle school running events each year. Each August, the park also hosts the annual Sumner Fest music and balloon festival.

VOLUNTEER PARK AT ARROWHEAD 1334 Drakes Creek Road

One of the city’s newest parks, Volunteer Park at Arrowhead is home to eight soccer fields that serve players of all ages. Conveniently located adjacent to the entrance to Knox Doss Middle and Dr. William Burrus Elementary schools, the park offers expanded soccer play and practice facilities, and it enhances the city’s ability

to attract and host large soccer tournaments.

WARRIOR BIKE TRAIL Saundersville Road

The Warrior Bike Trail is located on Saundersville Road close to nearby Veterans Park. The trail was developed as a joint effort between the Hendersonville Public Works Department and local trail biking enthusiasts. Nestled within a scenic wooded area, the park offers approximately 1.5 miles of trails that are suitable for riders of all ages.

HENDERSONVILLE GREENWAYS & TRAILS Throughout Hendersonville

Hendersonville’s greenways and trails are among the most utilized facilities in the park system. Integrated with both Drakes Creek Park and Sanders Ferry Park, the greenway system is home to thousands of runners, walkers and cyclists each year. Over time, the greenway expanse is expected to grow, offering safe and convenient recreational opportunities to citizens throughout the city.

COUNTRY HILLS GOLF COURSE 1501 Saundersville Rd

The 18-hole course at the Country Hills Golf Course in Hendersonville, Tennessee features 6211 Yards from the Blue The course rating is 69.7 and a slope rating of 120. Designed by Leon Howard, Country Hills Golf Course opened in 1990.

The Hendersonville Chamber Foundation is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit arm of the Hendersonville Area Chamber of Commerce whose mission is to provide educational resources to the Hendersonville community. The Foundation operates independently from the Chamber, and it is governed by its own board of directors.

Fundraising for the Foundation is obtained through personal and business donations, advertising sales for the Hendersonville City

Guide and the annual Freedom Festival event held every July 3.

Golden Apple Grants

The Hendersonville Chamber Foundation created the Golden Apple Grant program to advance K-12 education in the greater Hendersonville area. The purpose of the program is to provide funding to help address school needs and to develop creative new approaches that will have direct, positive impacts upon student learning success.

Not only do these projects impact the educational experience for the current year for which the award is made, but many of the projects have a shelf life of up to five years multiplying exponentially the number of students who benefit. Over the past 15 years, over \$310,000 has been awarded through this program. In 2019, the Foundation awarded grants totaling more than \$35,000 to teachers from eleven different schools. All grants are awarded during a special teacher recognition ceremony held each October.

Grant applicants must ensure that their proposed projects are consistent with the overall mission of their schools. Grants may be awarded to single teachers and classrooms, entire grade levels, specific academic disciplines, entire schools and may even encompass multiple schools.

All grant applications should include a discussion of overall project goals, deliverables, project timelines/ action steps and criteria for success.

Team and school-wide projects must also include the name of the grant administrator, as well as a listing of individual team members.

All Hendersonville area public and private K12 teachers are eligible to apply for the grants.

2018-2019 Golden Apple Grant Award Winner Profiles

Project: Full STEAM Ahead – Coding with Ozobots

Project Administrator: Sundy MacKorell

School: Indian Lake Elementary School

Grant Amount: \$2,990

Indian Lake Elementary librarian Sundy MacKorell wanted to enhance her students' knowledge of computers and robotics in support of her school's efforts to become a STEM/STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics and the Arts) accredited school. She was particularly interested in obtaining technology to help her students gain a better understanding of computer programming/coding.

Accordingly, MacKorell wrote a Golden Apple grant application to request funds to purchase a set of small robots (Ozobots) and related programming/support aids to be shared by students at her school.

"I wanted to provide our students with a fun, beneficial and easy-to-use resource to introduce them to the skill of coding," says MacKorell. Once the Ozobots arrived, MacKorell spent the next several weeks teaching her students how the robots operate and how to successfully program them to perform simple tasks. As time went on, the coding

assignments became more complex as students gained a better understanding of the robot capabilities and uses.

"All of my students fell in love with the robots from the start," says MacKorell. "They were amazed at what the little robots could do and how they operate."

During the school year, MacKorell used the robots to help her students gain a better understanding of their regular classroom assignments. Some of the coding projects involved storytelling, problem solving, life cycles, basic geometry and dictionary skills. By year end, her students had shown significant improvements in many different study areas.

"One fellow teacher asked if I had done anything differently this year regarding student dictionary skills. She said that unlike prior years, all of her students were able to easily locate guide words," recalls MacKorell. "I told her that what I did differently was to use the Ozobots to help teach the skills. It is amazing that such tiny little robots could make such a positive difference."

During the upcoming school year, MacKorell is eager to continue using the Ozobots to help teach skills that are essential to 21st century learners.

"I am so very thankful and appreciative that we were chosen for this grant," says MacKorell. "Our Ozobots are an important resource for our endeavor to go 'Full STEAM Ahead' at Indian Lake Elementary.

Project: School-Wide STEM Innovation
Project Administrator: Dr. Karen Jarratt

School: Station Camp Elementary School

Grant Amount: \$3,000

Several years ago, Station Camp Elementary School established a goal of becoming an accredited STEM school as designated by the Tennessee STEM Innovation Network (TSIN). Attaining STEM certification requires a rigorous, multiyear process that includes teacher self-evaluations.

Like her peers, Dr. Karen Jarratt was eager to help her school attain the coveted certification as quickly as possible. Accordingly, she applied for a Chamber Foundation Golden Apple grant to help her school prepare for the STEM accreditation process.

"One of the most critical components in the STEM certification process is demonstrating that the school has adequate student training facilities," says Dr. Jarratt. "I thought that applying for a Golden Apple grant would be a good way to assist us in building and supplying our STEM facilities."

Once her grant was approved and funded, Dr. Jarratt and her team began designing and equipping STEM training areas that would meet with TSIS accreditation standards. Two separate areas were designated in the school – a STEM training lab and a creative construction space known as a "Makerspace" area.

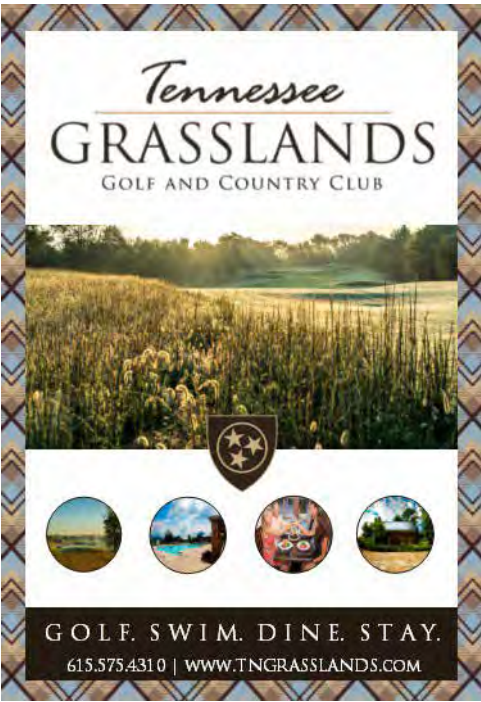
"Thanks to the Golden Apple grant, we were able to build out our workspaces and equip them with needed

materials,” says Dr. Jarratt. “We were able to purchase lab tables, equipment, supplies, Lego building/robotics materials and a coding set.”

Once the facilities were complete, teachers were able to utilize them for instructional purposes as they continued the STEM certification process. Earlier this year, the hard work of the Station Camp Elementary School administration and faculty

was rewarded when the school received its official STEM designation.

“On May 15, 2019, Tennessee Education Commissioner Dr. Penny Schwinn announced that Station Camp Elementary was now a STEM designated school,” says Dr. Jarratt. “Because of the generous grant from the Chamber Foundation, we were able to meet and exceed our goal.”

excelling IN EDUCATION

WHERE LEARNING
AND ACHIEVEMENT
COME FIRST

Fortunately, Hendersonville is blessed with some of the best public and private schools in the state of Tennessee. From kindergarten through high schools, Hendersonville children have a wide range of outstanding educational options. In addition, Hendersonville is able to boast of a comprehensive array of higher education options, ranging from advanced certificates through fully-accredited doctoral programs.

SUMNER COUNTY Public Schools

Hendersonville is served by multiple elementary, middle and high schools which are operated by the Sumner County Board of Education. Each school is dedicated to ensuring that all students receive well-balanced educations that help to prepare them for their futures.

While Hendersonville schools place a strong emphasis on academics, they

also provide students with multiple avenues for exploring music, the arts, athletics and extracurricular activities.

Public Elementary Schools

Hendersonville is served by eleven of the best elementary schools in Middle Tennessee. With caring faculties and strong community support, each of these schools is committed to help their students learn and achieve.

Two of the schools, Jack Anderson Elementary and Dr. William Burrus Elementary at Drakes Creek, have been designated STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics) schools.

Public Middle Schools

The middle school grades of six through eight are often among the most challenging periods faced by young learners. They can be awkward years in which students struggle trying to bridge the gap between childhood and young adulthood.

Hendersonville's five middle schools are committed to helping their students succeed during these years. Their dedicated faculties will help young teenagers continue their academic progress as they prepare for the rigors of high school.

Public High Schools

Older students in Hendersonville are fortunate to be served by three of the best public high schools in the state. Whether they attend Hendersonville, Beech or Station Camp, students will receive excellent educations with unparalleled extracurricular opportunities.

Each of the schools has a track record for graduating seniors who are well prepared for whatever opportunities await them, including college, trade school, the military or immediate employment.

Merrol Hyde Magnet School

Merrol Hyde Magnet School is a traditional academic school with a primary focus on foreign language. It is accredited by the Tennessee Department of Education and the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. The school operates under the Paideia philosophy, which blends traditional classroom training with specialized Socratic seminars and individual projects. Admission to Merrol Hyde Magnet school is a rigorous process that requires students to meet special acceptance criteria. Most applicants are typically in the top 15% of their class at their previous schools prior to coming to Merrol Hyde Magnet School.

SUMNER COUNTY

Middle College High School

The Sumner County Middle College High School is operated on a collaborative basis by the Sumner County Board of Education and Volunteer State Community College. The unique program is designed to give highly-motivated students opportunity to receive a high school diploma while earning credits toward a college degree or exploring vocational and career options. Most students earn enough college credits to graduate with both a high school diploma and an associate's degree at the same time.

Private Schools

Along with its outstanding public schools, Hendersonville is also served by several private schools that offer parents and students additional choices, including Pope John Paul II, which enrolls 600 high school students. Additionally, Hendersonville Christian Academy is a private school which enrolls more than 300 students from pre-K through high school.

COLLEGE EDUCATION
OPTIONS ARE VARIED
AND ABUNDANT

Over the past decade, there has been an explosion in higher education opportunities in the State of Tennessee. Beginning with the Tennessee HOPE Scholarship in 2003 and continuing with the Tennessee Promise (for recent high school graduates) and Tennessee Reconnect (returning adult students) programs, there has never been a more affordable time for state residents of all ages to pursue their dreams of higher education.

During the same time frame, there has also been a quiet revolution in higher education in Sumner County. Prior to this period,

residents seeking post high school educational opportunities beyond the community college level had to attend institutions located outside of the county. These options typically resulted in significantly higher educational costs due to campus room and board and/or commuting expenses.

However, local students today are facing a dramatically different educational landscape than their predecessors did just a few short years ago. The addition of Union University in 2008, coupled with the establishment of Welch College in 2016 and the continued growth of

Volunteer State Community College, have all combined to create a veritable explosion in educational opportunities and instructional delivery methods all in our community.

In addition, Sumner County offers a cooperative program with Volunteer State Community College called the Sumner County Middle College High School, which provides students with the opportunities to complete their high school diplomas and earn an associate's degree at the same time.

The continued growth of educational opportunities has placed Hendersonville residents in the unique position of being able to go from preschool through a doctoral program, all without ever having to leave the City by the Lake.

Union University

Originally founded in 1823 in Jackson, Tennessee, Union University established its local presence in 2008,



operating out of vacant space in Hendersonville's First Baptist Church. From 2008 until 2010, Union only offered graduate programs in Christian Studies through its church campus. During 2010, the university began offering an adult bachelor's degree completion program in Hendersonville under the direction of Dr. Renee' Dauer, who currently serves as the local Campus Director and Chair of the School of Adult and Professional Studies.

In 2012, Union relocated to a brand new dedicated 24,000 square-foot facility on Indian Lake Boulevard. Following this move, the university began offering many new undergraduate and graduate programs. Currently, these programs include undergraduate and graduate programs in nursing, graduate programs in education and an adult studies bachelor's degree completion program. Union also offers three post-graduate degrees through its Hendersonville campus – Education Specialist (EdS), Doctor of Education (EdD) and Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP). Furthermore, Union also offers several degree options entirely online, including an AA-CSB-accredited Master of Business Administration degree.

According to Dr. Dauer, over 90% of Union's approximately 100+ students at the Hendersonville campus are considered full-time, with ages ranging between 22 to 60 years old. The university follows the traditional three term school year (fall, spring and summer semesters) but also offers two accelerated terms in August and October that allow students to earn additional hours through concentrated short-term instruction. Per Dr. Dauer, "Union strives to meet people where they are in life and help them plot out

the path to finish a degree in their desired field of study. We help people reach their goals, changing their lives, changing their family's lives and changing their community."

Volunteer State Community College

Founded in 1971, Volunteer State Community College (Vol State) is the oldest institution for higher education located within the county. Located just minutes from Hendersonville in Gallatin, Vol State has served tens of thousands of area students since the early nineteen seventies.

Originally chartered as a community college to offer two-year Associate's degree programs, Vol State has continued to expand its programs over the years, adding additional majors as well as several professional certificates. Currently, Vol State offers more than 90 academic programs to its more than 8,100 students. According to Vol State President Dr. Jerry Faulkner, "the most popular field of study is the University Parallel program, which permits students to earn Associate's of Arts or Science degrees before transferring to four-year institutions to complete bachelor's degrees."

While its primary campus is in Gallatin, Vol State has a full slate of online courses and degree programs that permit students to attend college at any time and location. The college also maintains satellite campus locations in Cookeville, Livingston, Springfield, and soon, in Mt. Juliet.



Welch College

Welch college is the latest addition to the Hendersonville-area higher education landscape. Founded in Nashville in 1942 as Free Will Baptist Bible College, the school relocated to an all new campus in nearby Gallatin, Tennessee during 2016. Welch has the distinction of being the only higher education institution in Sumner County that offers residential dormitory housing for its students.

Welch offers a variety of undergraduate degree programs as well as a graduate Master of Arts in Theology and Ministry degree. Undergraduate courses of study include Biology-Pre-Med/Pre-Nursing, Business, English, Exercise Science, History, Ministry, Psychology and Teacher Education. Welch also offers an adult degree completion program in Enriched Studies (evenings and online) as well as several online associate's and bachelor's degree options. Finally, Welch offers a "dual enrollment" option with nearby Station Camp High School whereby students can earn college credits while still in their high school. According to President Matthew Pinson, who has served in that role since 2002, Welch's "emphasis is upon traditional students, aged 18 to 22, seeking a 4 year on-campus residential experience." This experience is designed to be like most residential colleges and universities, including the opportunity to join social clubs (similar to fraternity and sorority "rush" activities), participate in arts and cultural events and to participate in or attend intercollegiate athletic activities such as cross



country, volleyball, basketball, golf and soccer. Along with these activities, Welch students also participate in community service activities which provides over 10,000 hours of local assistance to area agencies each year.

As of the fall semester 2019, the

college has over 400 students enrolled in classes, most of whom reside in one of the school's two dormitories. Per Dr. Pinson, his "goal is to grow Welch's enrollment to 1,000 students or more over the coming years." He plans to accomplish this goal through several different approaches, including additional

on-campus students (and facilities), growth in online degree offerings, and the creation of a summer semester program aimed at non-Welch college students in Sumner County who seek the opportunity to earn additional hours while at home during summer break.

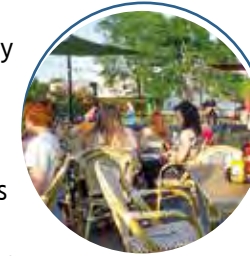

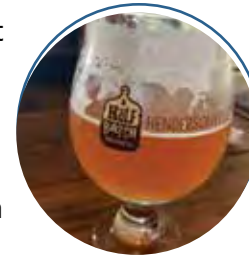

Formed by nearby Old Hickory Dam and the Cumberland River, the lake spans over 22,500 acres in Sumner and four other adjacent counties.

With a nominal pool elevation of 445 feet above sea level, Old Hickory Lake is perfectly suited for lake and river craft of all sizes. All dam and lake operations are managed year round by the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers.

While Old Hickory Lake is accessible from many points in Sumner County, Hendersonville is the hub, boasting over 26 miles of lakefront shoreline. In addition, Hendersonville has three marinas on the lake, Creekwood, Drakes

Creek and Anchor High. These marinas offer full-service for boaters to help them get the most out of long days on the lake.

Old Hickory Lake is known to anglers around the country for its wide variety of fish, including catfish, crappie, bass and walleye. The diversity of fish coupled with easy access and navigation makes Old Hickory Lake a popular location for professional fishing tournaments.

The lake is also home to a large number of waterfowl, including herons, cranes, gulls and eagles, including the majestic Bald Eagle. There are many wooded places surrounding the lake that are ideal for birdwatchers and nature lovers, including a 23-acre wildlife viewing area located near the Lock 3 Recreation area on Walton Ferry Road.

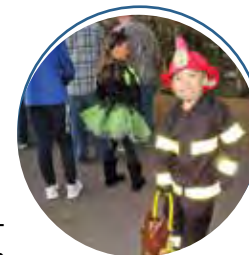

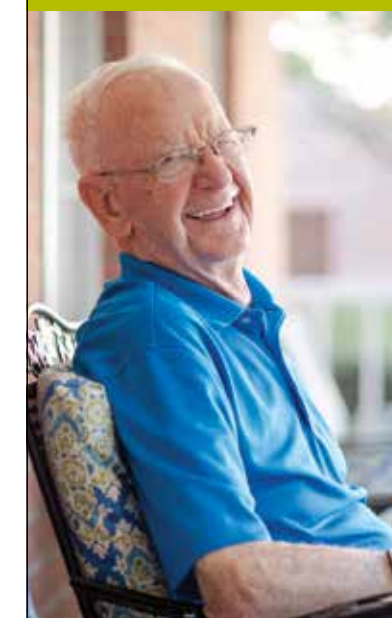
